School Administration

Safety and Security

- Top Priority Your child's safety and well-being
- Movement within school for visitors is restricted
- Minimise physical presence; make an appointment with teachers
- Parents must register at Security Post and produce a photo identification card for a Visitor sticker before proceeding to the General Office (GO)
- No parking within school compound

Access to School

- School is opened from Monday to Friday
- Main Gate (For morning drive through drop off):
 - 6.30 am to 7.30am
- Side Gate 1 (Beside Main Gate)



Morning Drop-off

- Parents driving to school may alight your child inside the school from 6.30 am to 7.30 am.
- Drop-off point: Sheltered bus-bay area after the library
- Speed limit is 15 km/h or less
- Slow down at the internal zebra crossing and Exit Gate B
- Do not double park when alighting your child as it will cause a congestion
- Carpark within school is for staff parking only







Morning Drop-off

- Please stop your vehicle nearer to this point if you need more time to drop off your child, this is to avoid holding up the queue.
- There are 4 drop off points, please stop at Point 1 if you are first in the line.
- Be patient. Do not sound your horn unless it is an emergency.

Dismissal

- Children will be brought to Side Gate 1 and 3 for dismissal from 1.20pm per staggered timing by levels
- Parents please wait at
 - ✓ Parents' Waiting Corner at Gate 1 for Side Gate 1 pick-up
 - ✓ HDB multi-purpose hall for Side Gate 3 pick-up
- Avoid parking along Anchorvale Drive and the service road behind Side Gate 3 during dismissal
- Use the multi-storey carparks at Blk 306A and 308C

Consuming food in school

- School has a comprehensive range of healthy food sold in the canteen
- 8 stalls Halal and non-Halal; 1 Western, 2 noodles, 3 rice and 2 drinks/snacks vendors

- If pupil requires home prepared meals, please ensure they bring their meals to school in recyclable containers
- Parents are not allowed to bring food to school (e.g. birthday celebration) as some children may be allergic to ingredients such as nuts and eggs

School Bus Transport

- Familiarise your child with drop off and pick-up arrangements
- Be punctual for pick-up as it may affect other pupils
- Remind your child on the following:
 - Seat belt must be worn at all times
 - Proper behaviour on the bus to be observed at all times
 - Refrain from consuming food in the school bus

Road Safety Precautions

- Cross only at designated traffic junctions when "Green" man is shown
- Follow instructions of traffic marshals; never dash across the road when the "Green" man is blinking under 10 secs
- Stop, Look, Walk policy at zebra crossings
- Within school compound, no playing in the carpark and all pupils to walk along walkways to exit points
- Parents to be role models

Attendance

- Regular and punctual school attendance is important
- Inform the Form Teacher if your child/ward is unable to attend school with a valid reason
- If FTs are not updated, an automated phone message will be sent to parents/guardians to alert on pupil's absence at 8.00 am.
- Parents will need to contact the General Office to explain the absence and to ensure supporting documents are given to the Form Teacher when your child/ward returns to school

Student Handbook

- The school will issue your child the Student Handbook in Jan 2023
- Student Handbook contains important info such as school rules, academic info, staff email etc.
- Parents and teachers can also write notes in the Student Handbook as a form of communication.
- Do check the Student Handbook on a daily basis.
